

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

Maybe harmful if swallowed. Causes skin and eye irritation. Avoid contact with the skin and eyes. Wear protective gloves and use personal protective equipment as required. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product and wash hands thoroughly after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use.

FIRST AID

If skin contact occurs remove contaminated clothing and wash with plenty of soap and running water. If eye contact occurs, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. For advice, or if you feel unwell, contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor immediately. DISPOSAL

Preferably dispose of product by use. Otherwise dispose of product and packaging at an approved landfill or other approved facility. Bury packaging in a suitable landfill, or if appropriate recycle.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Supplement at times such as in early spring when there are low magnesium levels, and gradually reduce daily allowance once risk periods are past.

1. Oral Drenching (post-calving)

Drench cows with 80-100 grams/cow/day. Addition of molasses or suitable sweeteners may improve palatability.

2. Medication of Drinking Water

Medicate the drinking water at a rate that delivers 60-100 grams/cow/day. Introduce slowly building up to this rate over a two to three week period. Addition of molasses or suitable sweeteners may improve initial acceptance. Also withdraw gradually over a similar period.

General tips for in-line water medication:

- Ensure that the dispenser is set up properly the intake pipe should be at least 100mm off the bottom of the tank
- Keep the dispenser in good working order and do not allow it to operate while the solution tank is empty
- Products should be pre-dissolved before adding to the solution tank
- Do not add solid products directly to the solution tank
- Do not mix different powders or different liquid concentrates together before pre-dissolving
- Only prepare enough concentrate in the solution tank to last for 1-2 days
- Avoid any mixtures that are known to be incompatible
- Avoid mixing more than 5 or 6 different products in the solution tank
