STORAGE:

PRODUCT INFORMATION

SPOREWET is an alcohol ethoxylate surfactant to be added to spray solutions for the application of Sporeguard fungicide for the prevention of facial eczema. It ensures a better retention of spray droplets to the target plants, better wetting the plant surface, and better spreading of spray droplets. It compensates for the disadvantage of coarse droplets sprays commonly produced by antidrift nozzles.

COMPATIBILITY

SPOREWET is compatible with most commonly used fungicides, insecticides and plant growth regulators. Do not mix **SPOREWET** with other surfactants; or highly acidic or highly alkaline chemicals.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SPOREWET will give best results with water rates of 100-200 litres/ha, as higher volumes may result in excessive run-off of spray liquid.

Mixing: Add SPOREWET as the last component to the spray tank. Partly fill the tank with water then add the Sporeguard in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications. Under slight agitation now add the SPOREWET and fill the tank completely. After addition of the SPOREWET to the spray tank, the liquid may turn cloudy but this does not affect the efficacy of the product. Spray the tank mix promptly. SPOREWET can be used with all types of spray nozzles.

For 100 litres per hectare of spray mix:

• Mix 300ml Sporeguard plus 100ml **SPOREWET** per 100 litres of water. For 200 litres per hectare of spray mix:

Mix 300ml Sporeguard plus 100ml SPOREWET per 200 litres of water.
