Read label carefully and obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

Harmful if swallowed or in contact with skin. Causes skin irritation and may cause an allergic skin reaction. Causes serious eye irritation. Suspected of damaging fertility or the unborn child as well as suspected of causing cancer. May cause damage to the immune, developmental, blood and haematopoietic systems. Do not breathe dust and use personal protective equipment as required. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product and wash hands thoroughly after handling. Contaminated work clothing should not be allowed out of the workplace and should be washed before reuse.

FIRST AID

If swallowed, rinse mouth. If skin contact occurs remove contaminated clothing and wash with plenty of soap and running water. If eye contact occurs, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. For advice, or if you feel unwell, contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor immediately. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

Toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects. Harmful to terrestrial vertebrates. Avoid release to the environment.

DISPOSAL

Preferably dispose of product by use. Otherwise treat the product so that it is no longer toxic and dispose of product and packaging at an approved landfill or other approved facility, or if appropriate recycle.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

In case of spillage wear appropriate protective clothing and prevent material from entering water ways. Absorb spills with inert material and place in waste containers. Sweep up solids without creating dust. Wash area with water and absorb with further inert material. Dispose of waste safely.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use at times of the year when additional supplementary trace elements and vitamins may be required, e.g. pre-mating and late pregnancy.

Pour the contents of one 1kg sachet into a 5L backpack, add water up to 5L and shake gently to dissolve. Once dissolved, orally drench this solution at the recommended dose rate of:

• 5ml per lamb • 10ml per adult sheep • 10ml per calf • 50ml per adult cattle

Each 10ml dose of drench solution (equivalent to 2g of powder) contains 280mg elemental iodine (as EDDI), 2mg elemental selenium (as sodium selenate), 2.5mg elemental cobalt (as cobalt sulphate), 6mg elemental zinc (as zinc sulphate monohydrate), 20,000 IU vitamin A, 10,000 IU vitamin D and 200 IU vitamin E.

Each 1kg sachet treats 500 adult sheep or 100 adult cattle.
