Read label carefully and obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or in contact with the skin. Causes serious eye damage. May cause an allergic skin reaction. Suspected of causing cancer and damaging fertility or the unborn child. May cause damage to the cardiovascular, alimentary, hepatic and renal systems. Do not breathe dust. Wear protective gloves and clothing plus eye and face protection. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product and wash hands thoroughly after handling. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area. Contaminated work clothing should not be allowed out of the workplace and should be washed before reuse.

FIRST AID

If swallowed, rinse mouth but DO NOT induce vomiting. If inhaled, remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If skin contact occurs remove contaminated clothing and wash with plenty of soap and running water. If eye contact occurs, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. For advice, or if you feel unwell, contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor immediately. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

Very toxic to aquatic life. Harmful to the soil environment and terrestrial vertebrates. Avoid release to the environment.

DISPOSAL

Preferably dispose of product by use. Otherwise treat the product so that it is no longer toxic and dispose of product and packaging at an approved landfill or other approved facility, or if appropriate recycle.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

In case of spillage wear appropriate protective clothing and prevent material from entering water ways. Absorb spills with inert material and place in waste containers. Sweep up solids without creating dust. Wash area with water and absorb with further inert material. Dispose of waste safely.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The recommended dose rate is 5gms per cow per day.

Each 5gm dose contains 150mg elemental copper (as copper glycinate), 5mg elemental selenium (as sodium selenate), 10mg elemental cobalt (as cobalt sulphate heptahydrate), 20mg elemental iodine (as EDDI chelate) and 600mg elemental zinc (as zinc sulphate monohydrate).

WARNING

Do not exceed the recommended dose rates. This product contains selenium and copper and should only be used where a relevant deficiency has been diagnosed, and should not be used at the same time as any other selenised or copper-containing product without consulting a veterinarian or animal health adviser. In sheep, liver levels of copper may be quite variable and consequently there is always a risk of copper poisoning occurring following copper supplementation in this species.
