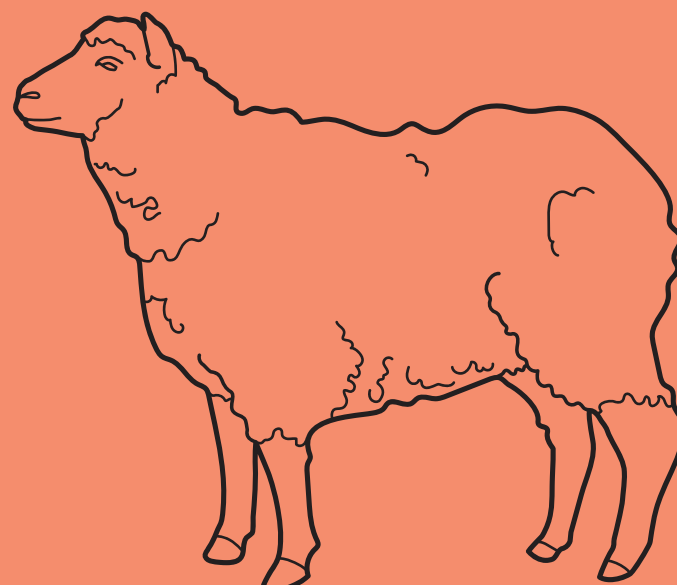

CLOSANTEL PLUS | READ LABEL CAREFULLY BEFORE USING

Read label carefully and obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

May be harmful if swallowed. Wash hands and exposed skin before meals and after use. Repeated exposure may cause skin allergy. Avoid skin contact. Abamectin and Closantel may possibly affect development and/or reproduction. Abamectin may possibly have effects on or via lactation. Closantel may possibly affect the liver. Handle with care.

FIRST AID

If swallowed do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. If skin or hair contact occurs remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

Very toxic to aquatic organisms. Avoid contamination of any water supply with product or empty container. Very toxic to the soil environment. Harmful to terrestrial vertebrates. Very toxic to terrestrial invertebrates. Avoid release to the environment.

DISPOSAL

Preferably dispose of the product by use. Otherwise dispose of product and packaging at an approved landfill or other approved facility. Avoid contamination of any water source. Triple rinse container immediately after emptying and pour rinsate onto waste ground. Do NOT use container for any other purpose.

CONTAINS: 1g/L abamectin, 50g/L closantel and 15.7g/L Cobalt disodium EDTA.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

In case of spillage, wear appropriate protective clothing and prevent material from entering waterways. Absorb spills with inert material and place in waste containers. Wash the area with water and absorb with further inert material. Dispose of waste safely.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

By law the user must take due care, obtaining expert advice when necessary, to avoid unnecessary pain and distress when using the product other than as directed on the label.

Shake well before use. CLOSANTEL PLUS is ready to use through standard drenching equipment. Rinse gun with water immediately after use. A representative sample of animals should be weighed before treatment. Dose the mob to the heaviest animal by live weight in each group (ewes, wethers, rams, lambs). Do not underdose. Where there is a large variation in size within the group, dose rate should be based on the label directions for each weight range. Drafting into two or more lines may be appropriate, to avoid excessive overdosing. Correct drenching technique should be used. Check accuracy of drench guns regularly.

PRECAUTIONS

Do not use at the same time as any other selenised fertilizer, prill or product without consulting a veterinarian. Do not exceed stated dose volume and frequency. Do not use in lambs under 15kg or 4 weeks of age.

RESISTANCE

Resistance may develop to any anthelmintic. Ask your local veterinary practitioner or animal health advisor for recommended parasite management practices for your area to reduce development of resistance. It is advisable that a resistance test be conducted regularly when using any parasite treatment.

EFFICACY

Contains 1g/L abamectin a broad spectrum drench of the macrocyclic lactone group, 50g/L closantel (as sodium salt) a narrow spectrum salicylanilide drench and 0.5g/L selenium and 2.2 g/L cobalt. It has persistent activity up to 42 days against Barber's Pole (*Haemonchus contortus*).

At recommended doses, this product is effective against sensitive strains of the following mature and immature roundworms and liver fluke in sheep:

Barber's Pole - *Haemonchus contortus*

Stomach hair worm - *Trichostrongylus axei*

Black scour worm - *Trichostrongylus colubriformis* and *Trichostrongylus vitrinis*

Brown stomach worm - *Teladorsagia circumcincta* and *Teladorsagia trifurcata*

Small intestinal worm - *Cooperia oncophora*, *Cooperia surnabada* and *Cooperia punctata*

Thin-necked intestinal worm - *Nematodirus spathiger*

Liver fluke - *Fasciola hepatica*

Lungworm - *Dictyocaulus filaria*

DOSAGE: SHEEP BY ORAL DRENCH

1ml/5kg body weight delivering 0.2mg/kg abamectin, 10mg/kg closantel, 0.1mg/kg selenium and 0.44mg/kg cobalt

Do not use in lambs under 15kg or 4 weeks of age
