IF THIS HAPPENS										
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call emergency services: Dial 111									
Spill or leak	Do NOT touch or walk through spilled material. Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Stop leak when safe to do so. Prevent entry into waterways, drains, or confined areas. Absorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.									
Fire	Report large spills to Emergency Services at 0800 CHEMCALL (0800 243 622)   Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Fumes and combustion products produced in a fire may be toxic and / or irritating. Small   Fire: Use dry chemical, CO <sub>2</sub> , water spray or foam. Large fire: Use water fog, foam, or dry agent. If possible, use foam   blanket to contain product. Avoid using AFFF. If safe to do so, move undamaged containers from fire area. Cool container   with flooding quantities of water until well after fire is out.									
FIRST AID										
If Swallowed:	Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician and / or transport to emergency facility immediately.									
If in Eyes:	Flush eyes thoroughly with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses after the initial 1-2 minutes and continue flushing for several additional minutes. If effects continue, consult a physician, preferably an ophthalmologist.									
If on Skin:	Wash the skin well with plenty of water.									
If Inhaled:	Move person to fresh air; if effects occur, consult a physician.									
STORAGE AND SEGREGATION										
<b>Storage:</b> Store in a cool dry place at room temperature (i.e. 5°C to 25°). Store in tightly closed original container, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight when not in use. Store away from foodstuffs, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use. See product label for further handling / storage precautions relative to the end use of this product.
