STARTER DRENCH™ | READ LABEL CAREFULLY BEFORE USING

Read label carefully and obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

Causes mild skin irritation and serious eye irritation. Wear protective gloves plus eye and face protection. Wash hands thoroughly after handling.

FIRST AID

If eye contact occurs, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If skin irritation occurs, for advice, or if you feel unwell, contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor immediately. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.

DISPOSAL

Preferably dispose of product by use. Otherwise dispose of product and packaging at an approved landfill or other approved facility, or if appropriate recycle.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake or stir well before use. Administer by oral drenching or addition to supplementary feed.

The dose rate is 1 litre per cow as a single drench as soon as practical after calving.

Additional doses of ½ - 1 litre daily for up to four days may be given.

WARNING

Do not exceed 3 litres per cow per day. As this product contains calcium, do not dose before calving unless under veterinary advice.

Store in the original container, tightly closed, locked up, away from direct sunlight and below 30°C.
