Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call emergency services: Dial 111							
Spill or leak	Do NOT touch or walk through spilled material. Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Stop leak if safe to do so. Prevent entry into waterways, drains, or confined areas. Absorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
