STORAGE

Keep out of reach of children.

Store in accordance with NZS 8409 Management of Agrichemicals. Store in original container tightly closed in a locked, dry, cool, well ventilated area away from foodstuffs, fertilisers and seeds,

Stores containing 1000L of ASSIST EASY RED are subject to signage and secondary containment. More than 1000L require emergency response plans.

PERSONAL PROTECTION

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and do not inhale spray mist.

Otherwise crush or puncture and bury in an approved landfill. Do not burn container. Do not use container for any other purpose. Dispose of product only by using according to label directions or dispose of safely at a managed landfill.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

ASSIST EASY RED is a spray marker due for adding to spray solutions for easier identification of treated areas to avoid unnecessary overlapping and help prevent missed areas. Wash out spray equipment thoroughly after use. If product residue is left in equipment, colouration of subsequent sprays can be expected.

DO NOT allow concentrate, solution or spray drift to come into contact with desirable surfaces such as motor vehicle paint work.

RATE OF USE

Use the higher rate if more intense colour marking is required. If terrain is difficult to mark or a greater intensity of colour is required increase the concentration of ASSIST EASY RED in the spray solution. Experimentation for individual users will establish an economic rate for application.

KNAPSACK

5-10ml per 10L water.

HAND GUN or BOOM SPRAYING

50-100ml per 100L water.

MIXING

Add ASSIST EASY RED to water in the spray tank first, agitate or mix thoroughly before adding any other product.

COMPATIBILITY

Under most circumstances ASSIST FASY RED is compatible with most pesticides including brush weed herbicides. Several factors can affect this and therefore it is recommended that on site compatibility tests are carried out prior to using this product.
