PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Granular Ammonium Sulphate provides an equal balance of readily available nitrogen and sulphur meeting short term nutrient decencies and promoting vigorous growth in a wide range of plants such as vegetables, shrubs and lawns.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Granular Ammonium Sulphate is typically applied at a rate of 15 grams per square metre at planting, water in well. For use on established plants apply 15 grams per square metre, water in well. For use on established lawn apply 15-20 grams per square metre, water in well. Avoid fertiliser contacting paths, hard surfaces and driveways as the fertiliser may stain or discolour these surfaces.
