Read label carefully and obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Urea is a nitrogen fertiliser containing quick release nitrogen, suitable for boosting growth of vegetables and garden plants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

10-15 grams/square metre recommended throughout the year. Smaller more frequent applications are advised. Water into soil after application, dissolving it at a 20:80 ratio. Apply at the end of the day to reduce risk of leaf burn. Avoid fertiliser contacting paths, hard surfaces and driveways as the fertiliser may stain or discolour these surfaces.

COMPONENTS

Nitrogen (N): 46.0%. Phosphorus (P): 0.0%. Potassium (K): 0.0%. Sulphur (S): 0.0%. Magnesium (Mg): 0.0%. Calcium (Ca): 0.0%.

CONTAINS

Urea: 99-100%.

HANDLING PRECUATIONS AND STORAGE

HANDLING

Avoid generating dusts, do not breathe dusts. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Do not eat drink or smoke when using this product. If additional safety information is required, refer to the Safety Data Sheet (SDS). For a copy of the SDS phone 0800 100 123.

STORAGE

Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep out of hands of children.
