GENERAL INFORMATION:
ECObait® IP is a unique product containing iron phosphate, which is a natural component of soil. It is a specially formulated bait. Any unmet bait will degrade and become part of the soil.
After ingesting this bait (even in small amounts), snails and slugs cease feeding, which provides immediate protection to plants. Dead snails and slugs may not be visible as they often crawl away to secluded places to die. Plant protection will be observed in the dramatic decrease in plant damage.
Where the pest pressure is heavy, it may be necessary to repeat the application. Best results are achieved by application during mild damp weather when snails and slugs are most active. Snails need to be active to come into contact with the bait.
Scatter baits evenly using an appropriate applicator. DO NOT place in heaps. Clean up any spilled baits, including after filling applicator.

TIMING:
Apply baits when crops are most vulnerable and when the pest is evident and active. For broadcast crops, start when any/immune tingers snail and slug activity in autumn or spring.
Best results may be achieved by applying just before or at crop emergence where crops are being sown. For transplants apply at time of transplanting. See your distributor for further advice.

For most infestations, use this lower rate. For moderate to high infestations, use a higher rate. Re-apply every 10-14 days or when pellets have disappeared.
Horticultural crops including: Fruit (including grapevines), Citrus orchards, Vegetable and Berry crops, Ornamentals	Other		When applying to crops, ensure pellets do not become lodged in plant foliage.
